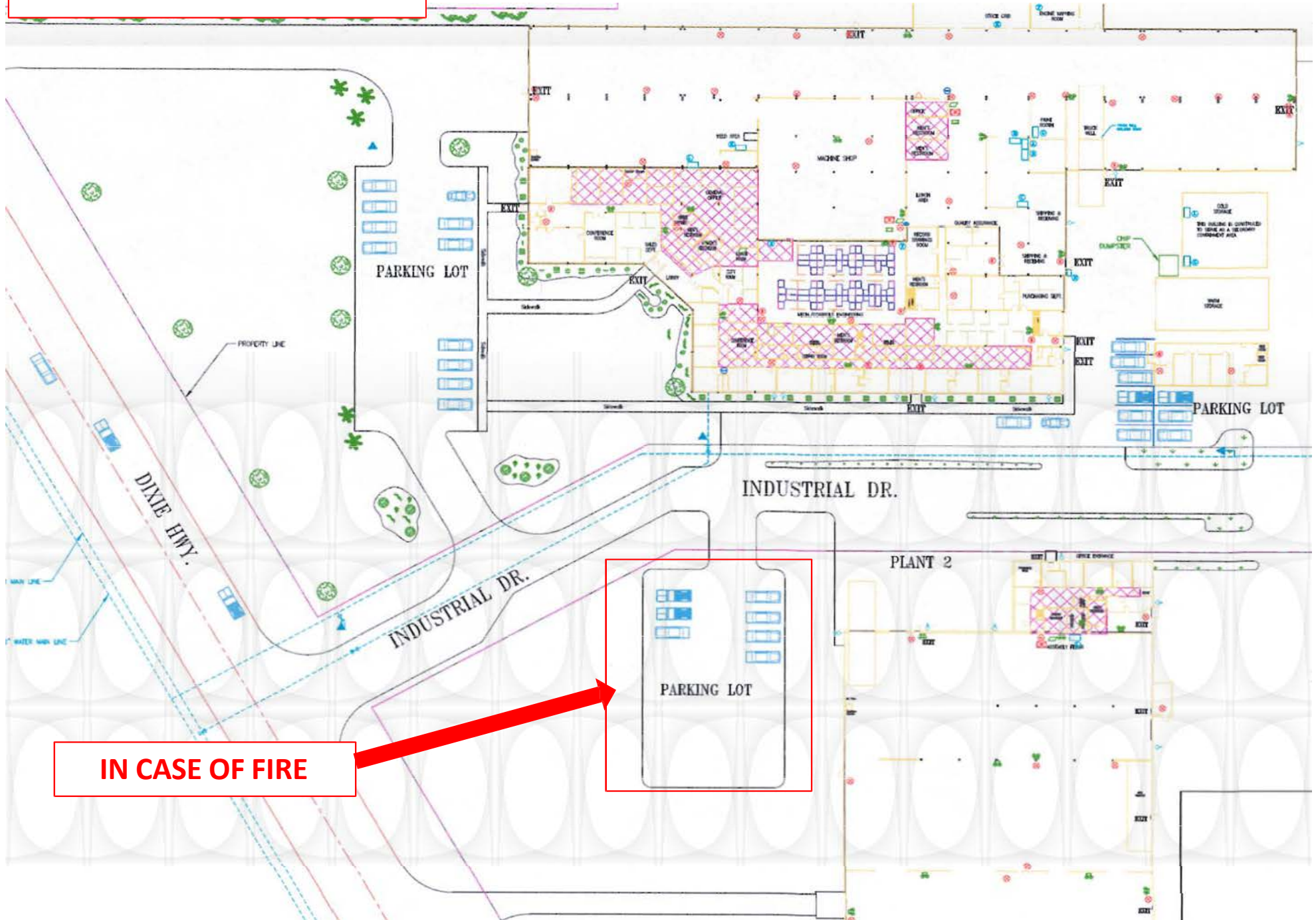

WHAT TO DO IN AN EMERGENCY?

<i>TYPE</i>	<i>RESPONSE</i>
Medical	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Page (dial 7444) the Emergency Response Team to that location. ● If needed, call 911. ● Dial 0 and report the location, nature/type, and whether 911 is coming. ● Avoid contact with any blood or bodily fluids.
Severe Weather	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● If instructed over paging system, report to your designated safe area. ● Do not leave the premises without approval from the Emergency Coordination Team.
Fire – Minor (no fire alarm)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Put out fire with fire extinguisher. ● Page (dial 7444) Emergency Response Team to that location.
Fire – Severe	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Call 911. ● Page (dial 7444) to alert Emergency Response Team. ● Evacuate all personnel from the area. ● If the fire alarm sounds: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Promptly exit the building. ● Go to the parking lot West of Plant 2. ● Go to your sign (Mfg/Eng/Admin); report to your Supervisor. ● Do not leave the premises without approval from Emergency Coordination Team
Chemical Spills	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Page (dial 7444) the Spill Response Team to that location. ● The Spill Response Team will supervise clean-up of the spill. ● Evacuate all personnel from the spill area.
Other	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Apply good judgment and remain calm. ● Do not endanger your personal health and safety. ● Follow instructions from the Emergency Coordination Team or Emergency Response Team.
